Have had several requests for recipes of goodies served at recent parties, so here are a few!

SUSAN WRIGHT'S MAGIC COOKIE BARS

1 (6oz) pkg semi-sweet chocolate chips 1 (14oz) can sweetened condensed milk 1/2 C. margarine 1 C. chopped pecans 1 1/3 C. flaked coconut 1 1/2 C graham cracker crumbs



Preheat oven to 350 degrees (325 for glass). In 9x13 inch baking pan, melt butter in oven. Sprinkle crumbs over butter & press into bottom of baking pan. Pour sweetened condensed milk evenly over crumbs. Top with remaining ingredients (I put chips on last); press down. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool. Chill if desired. Cut into bars. Store loosely covered at room temperature.

PATSY McINTIRE'S MICROWAVE FUDGE

3/4 cup butter or margarine
3 cups sugar
2/3 cup evaporated milk or cream
1 jar marshmallow creme
1 teaspoon vanilla\
1 cup pecans (or nuts of your choice)

Micro 3/4 cup butter (or margarine) until melted. Add 3 cups sugar &

2/3 cups cream (or evaporated milk). Micro on high 5 minutes, stirring after 3 minutes. Be sure it is boiling good. Mix well when 5 minutes are up. Micro 5 1/2 minutes on high, stirring 3 minutes. Add 1 package chocolate chips, stirring until melted. Add a jar Marshmallow Crème, 1 teaspoon vanilla & 1 cup pecans (optional). Pour in lightly buttered 9x13 inch pan & let harden. (If you're in a hurry, putting it in the freezer speeds up the process.)



GABBY REDDAM'S ARTICHOKE CASSEROLE/DIP

1 cup mayonnaise; 1 teaspoon fresh garlic (or powder).1 cup grated Parmesan cheese (fresh; shredded cheese section)

2 (6.5 oz) jars marinated Artichoke Hearts, drained 2 cups shredded Mozzarella cheese

Mix all ingredients in large bowl & pour into 8x8 inch baking dish. Bake 30 minutes in 350 degree oven until lightly browned & bubbly. The key is not to let the grease (mayo) separate from dip; it cannot "mix" back together & won't taste good.

C chopped Pecans
 C (2 sticks) Butter
 C Brown Sugar
 bag (8 oz) Semi-sweet Choc. Chips

Spray 9x13 baking dish with cooking spray Spread chopped Pecans evenly in dish Melt Butter & Brown Sugar (medium high), stirring constantly until 300 deg. (use thermometer) Pour evenly over Pecans. Pour Chocolate Chips on the mixture. Wait 30 seconds to allow mixture to soften, and spread. Refrigerate for a few hours; when cooled, cut into bars.
